Pre-Anesthetic Form

Your pet is being admitted to our clinic today for an anesthetic procedure. To ensure the best possible outcome; it is recommended that **pre-anesthetic lab work** be performed on your pet. The lab work allows us to evaluate your pet's kidney and liver function. Knowing how your pet's internal organs are functioning will give us a better idea of how they will handle the anesthesia or alert us to unseen problems. An abnormality may indicate that we need to change the type of anesthetic used, or may cause us to postpone the procedure until a later date.

_____ **Yes,** I understand the importance of **pre-anesthetic lab work** and would like it to be performed on my pet before the anesthetic procedure at a cost of **\$32-55.00**

_____ **No,** I understand the risk of anesthesia and do not wish to have pre-anesthetic lab work performed on my pet.

While under anesthesia it is the perfect opportunity for us to provide your pet with a form of **permanent identification**. This can be done by administering a **microchip** that is inserted under the skin between the shoulder blades; at a cost of **\$35.00**. Animal shelters and veterinary hospitals have microchip reader's which will be able to read the microchip if your pet became lost.

_____ **Yes,** I would like my pet to receive a **Microchip** as a form of permanent identification.

_____ **No,** I would not like my pet to receive a form of permanent identification at this time.

Your pet may receive an injection of 24 hour **anti-inflammatory/pain medication** (at an additional charge) while under anesthetic depending on the surgical procedure that he/she is undergoing. However, your pet may become painful when the medication wears off. We would be glad to send home an oral pain/anti-inflammatory medication for an additional cost.

_____ **Yes,** I would like my pet to receive an oral pain medication following surgery at an additional charge.

_____ **No,** I would not like additional pain medication sent home with my pet.
